Applications are invited for the following positions:

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR, DEPARTMENT OF LAND RESOURCE MANAGEMENT AND AGRICULTURAL TECHNOLOGY – AC/12/361/19 (1 POST) (R&T)

Applicants must be holders of a Ph.D degree in Soil Science from a recognized university, with specialization in Soil Physics and Soil Fertility. They must have at least eight (8) years teaching experience at both undergraduate and postgraduate degree level, three (3) of which must be at Senior Lecturer level. They must have supervised to completion at least two (2) students at doctoral level and three (3) students at masters level. Applicants must have a minimum of forty eight (48) equivalent publication points as Senior Lecturer, of which at least thirty two (32) should be from refereed scholarly journals. They must also have attracted research or development funds as Senior Lecturer level.

They will also be expected to carry out research in their areas of specialization. They will also be expected to participate in Departmental, Faculty, College and University activities.

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR, DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURAL ECONOMICS – AC/12/362/19 (1 POST) (R&T)

Applicants must be holders of a Ph.D degree in Agricultural Economics or its equivalent from a recognized university, with specialization in Agricultural Marketing or Agricultural Policy. They must have at least eight (8) years teaching experience at both undergraduate and postgraduate degree level, three (3) of which must be at Senior Lecturer level. They must have supervised to completion at least two (2) students at doctoral level and three (3) students at masters level.
