Qualifications

- Bachelors' degree in medicine or nursing
- Registration with Medical Practitioners & Dentists Board or Nursing Council of Kenya
- Minimum of five (5) years' work experience, one (1) year at the supervisory level
- Experience managing HIV programs
- Experience managing key populations programs
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Excellent analytical skills
- Innovative with a high degree of initiative and organizational skills

Duties and Responsibilities

- In collaboration with the project team and stakeholders, provide technical leadership and management of AfyaJijini's integrated key population strategies.
- Work with the AfyaJijini technical team to develop recommendations and operational strategies that engage both individuals and communities as well as health facilities, local NGOs, and other stakeholders to address key population health barriers.
- Plan and lead trainings and other capacity strengthening activities for key populations for project staff, partners, health facilities, communities, and sub-county/County government. Focus on improving the quality and sensitivity of health services for key populations at project sites.
- Develop tools and approaches to improve HIV prevention behaviors among key populations.
- Integrate project key population approaches into the project's wider health systems strengthening strategic objective and ensure integration with other project technical areas.
- Work closely with AfyaJijini's M&E team to establish systems for measuring the outcomes of key population interventions for routine project monitoring and special evaluations.

- Participate in relevant government technical working groups and key technical meetings.
- Operationalize the strategy for providing services to key populations.
- Help establish and institutionalize a referral strategy between drop-in centres and health facilities.
- Work with the AfyaJijini technical team and M&E team to establish and operationalize a database for key populations.
- Work with the AfyaJijini technical team to regularly update strategy for youth who are key populations.
- Represent AfyaJijini in technical capacity at County, sub-county, and facility level meetings.
- Represent UoN-CHIVPR in the weekly AfyaJijini meetings.
- Examine facility operations and systems and recommend ways to improve outputs and outcomes.
- Operationalize data demand and information use at designated facilities on KP services.
