

UoN Receives A Donation Worth 100M

The University of Nairobi (UoN) has received a donation of equipment and accessories worth 100 Million from National Oil Corporation Kenya (NOCK) for training.

A team of staff from UoN on Tuesday, July 6th, 2016 visited the National Oil Park in Industrial Area to assess the state of the equipment donated.
