He took up the full position of Cabinet Secretary for Internal Security and Coordination of National Government after being appointed by President Uhuru Kenyatta in January 2018 in the president's second comprehensive cabinet appointments. On the 22nd of January 2019, President Uhuru Kenyatta, through Executive Order Number 1 of 2019, appointed him chairperson of the National Development Implementation and Communication Cabinet Committee. The committee is composed of all Cabinet Secretaries, The Attorney-General and the Head of the Public Service who acts as the secretariat. He holds



and Social Council, Office of the President. This is a top advisory government think tank whose flagship project was formulating Vision 2030.

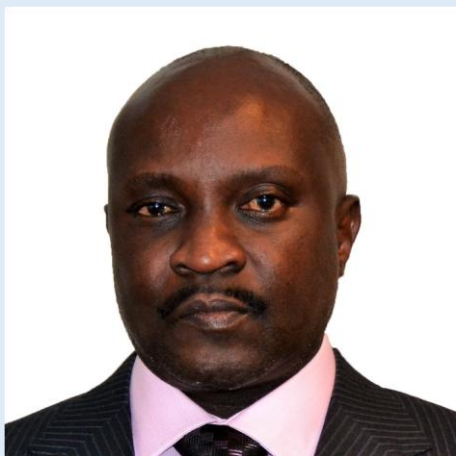

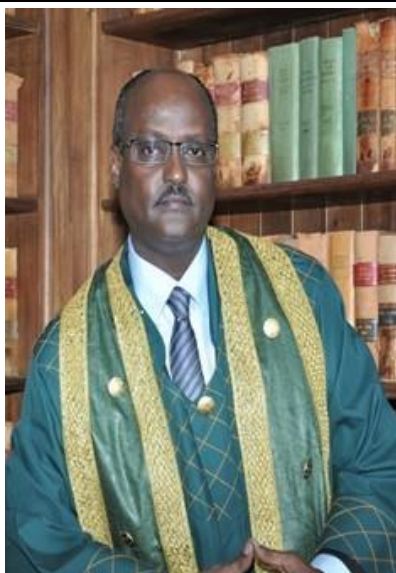

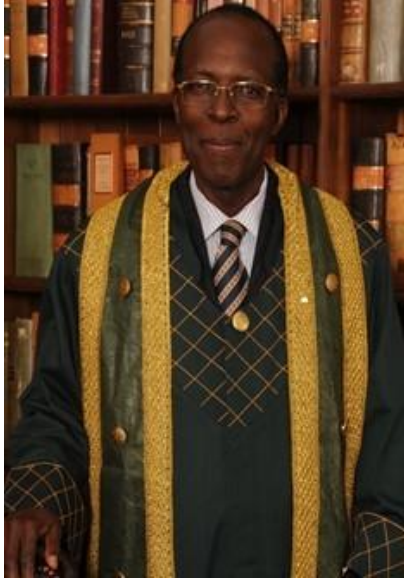

Judge of the Supreme Court of Kenya

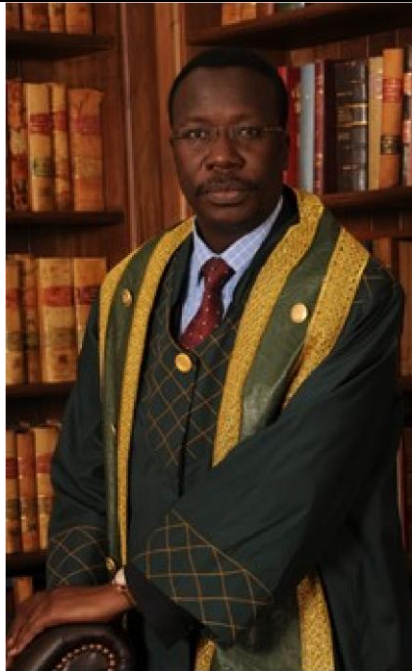
