STUDY NURSE, E-MOTIVE RESEARCH PROJECT - AD/6/59/22 - 1 POST

The Project

E-MOTIVE is a World Health Organization (WHO) cluster randomized trial to be conducted in fourteen (14) hospitals in Kenya. This is a two (2) year research project seeking to deliver a reduction in morbidity and mortality by early detection and treatment of post-partum hemorrhage using the MOTIVE bundle. The project is in its last phase (one year intervention phase).

The Position

The project operations are distributed nationwide and this position will be placed in Coast region.

Job specifications

- An applicant must have KCSE or its equivalent qualification with a pass in English.
- He/she must also be qualified as Kenya Registered Nurse/Midwife OR Kenya Registered Community Health Nurse OR have a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing.
- He/she should have at least one (1) year working experience post qualification in a busy maternity unit.
- He/she should have basic computer knowledge particularly in Microsoft Office applications and good IT skills.
- Training and experience in research will be an added advantage.

Job description

The successful candidate will be expected to:

- Screen and enroll eligible participants in the study and ensure proper administration of consent procedures.
- He/she will also administer screening and enrollment questionnaire to the participants
- Ensure data is collected accurately and resolve discrepancies
- Participate in training study site team members distributed nationwide
- Prepare weekly monthly and quarterly reports for the study coordinator.

Terms of appointment

This a position whose tenure is seven (7) months contract.
