The Position

The position is domiciled in the Department of Clinical Medicine and Therapeutics in the Faculty of Health Sciencies, under the Monitor and Prevent Antimicrobial Resistance in Kenya (MAP-AMR Kenya) Project. This is a five (5) year CDC project that will be conducted in three (3) hospitals: namely Kenyatta National Hospital, The Nairobi Hospital and The National Spinal Injury Referral Hospital.

Location

This is a full time position based at the University of Nairobi, Department of Clinical Medicine and Therapeutics, its holder reports to the Project Principal Investigator.

- ii) Developing M&E guidelines, data collection, management and analysis protocols
- iii) Ensuring source documents are safeguarded and that optimal data quality is maintained

- vii) Statistical analysis of routine project data
- viii) Resolving data queries and carrying out data trend analysis
