An applicant must be a holder of an earned PhD in any of the following fields: Geography; Environmental Studies; Population Studies **OR** a Master's Degree in any of the following fields: Geography; Environmental Studies; Population Studies plus a PhD registration in the relevant field from a University recognized by University of Nairobi Senate (in special cases) with at least three (3) years teaching experience at University level or in a research or in industry in the relevant area or any other equivalent qualification from a University recognized by the University of Nairobi Senate. He/she must have a minimum of eight (8) publication points from peer reviewed journals with; a minimum of two (2) publications in refereed journals or two (2) scholarly book chapters or published teaching modules two two scholarly or (2) peer reviewed (2) working/occasional/discussion papers. The applicant must also show evidence of community service. He/she must be registered with a relevant professional body where applicable.

The successful candidate will among other assignments be expected to teach both undergraduate and postgraduate students, carry out research, participate in Departmental, Faculty and University activities.
