LECTURER, DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN PATHOLOGY, FACULTY OF HEALTH SCIENCES, AC/7/111/24 – 1 POST

An applicant must be a holder of an earned PhD in Medical Biochemistry or any other equivalent qualification from a University recognized by the University of Nairobi Senate **OR** a Master's Degree in Medical Biochemistry (Clinical Chemistry) plus a PhD registration in the relevant field from a University recognized by University of Nairobi Senate (in special cases) with at least three (3) years teaching experience at University level or in a research or in industry in the relevant area. He/she must have a minimum of eight (8) publication points from peer reviewed journals with; a minimum of of two (2) publications in refereed journals or two (2) scholarly book chapters or two (2) scholarly published teaching modules or two (2) peer reviewed working/occasional/discussion papers. The applicant must also show evidence of community service. He/she must be registered with a relevant professional body where applicable.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach and supervise undergraduate and postgraduate students within the Department of Human Pathology as well as undertake research in their area of specialization. They are also expected to provide routine diagnostic services at Kenyatta National Hospital, in addition to participating in Departmental, Faculty and University activities.
