

Applications are invited for the following positions:

PRINCIPAL CATERING OFFICER GRADE 13, STUDENTS WELFARE AUTHORITY – AC/3/31/20 (RE-ADVERTISEMENT) (1 POST) (R&T)

Applicants must have a Masters degree in Food Technology or Institutional Management or Hotel Management or equivalent plus five (5) years working experience at senior catering level, three (3) of which must be at the level of Senior Catering Officer Grade 12. Those with a Bachelors degree in Food Technology or Institutional Management or Hotel Management plus ten (10) years experience in institutional/hotel management in a busy environment, three (3) of which must be at the level of Senior Catering Officer Grade 12 will also be considered. They must be computer literate.
