## The Project:

The HIP Study, based at the Faculty of Health Sciences (Centre for Healthcare Quality and Innovation), is seeking to hire 15 temporary Research Associates for a three-month period in Nairobi, Kiambu, and Kitui. The successful candidates will report to the Evaluation Team Lead.

#### Job Purpose:

Recruitment of study participants and data (qualitative and quantitative) data collection.

#### Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Operationalize study SOPs on site activation, data extraction, participant recruitment, and data collection.
- 2. Ensure compliance to study protocol and institutional guidelines.
- 3. Implement study activities including community engagement, information giving on study aims and procedures, obtaining informed consent and sample collection.
