Applicants must have KCSE Mean Grade C (plain) with credits in relevant subjects. (Those who were employed in the University before 2007 will be considered with the grades they already have.) They must have a Diploma in any of the following areas; Medical Laboratory Technology, Animal Production, Agriculture, Animal Health, Wildlife Sciences or equivalent plus 3 years' experience as Trainee Technologist Grade III/IV or a position of equivalent responsibility.

The successful candidates will be expected to conduct clinical diagnostic tests in hematology, biochemistry, molecular and microbiology laboratories; sample preparation, maintenance and operation of equipment; and quality control, organize and also prepare teaching materials for practical classes for both undergraduate and postgraduate students, keep inventory of all items/drugs in the Theriogenology, Surgery and Medicine units, Assist in handling of animals during treatment and student practicals/demonstrations as well as assisting in research projects in the Department.

They must also be registered with their relevant professional bodies where applicable and show evidence of continuous professional development.
